

INSON FLOOR CLEANING / BURNISHING PROCEDURES



Always use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment as stated on the label or SDS.

GETTING STARTED

Step 1:

Temporarily blockade the area you will be working and remove any movable objects within the area.

Step 2:

- Use a floor scraper to remove any gum or foreign objects stuck to the floor.
- Use a clean dust mop to remove any loose surface debris.

MOP AND BUCKET INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1:

Using a mop and bucket:

- Fill your bucket with cold tap water and diluted Heavy-Duty Neutral Floor Cleaner concentrate according to the label or fill using the "TruFill" Dispensing System
- Clean the area with a clean mop, changing the cleaning solution when the bottom of your bucket is no longer
- Finish by thoroughly rinsing out the mop head and bucket.

AUTO SCRUBBER INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1:

Using an Auto scrubber

Fill the tank using cold water and Heavy-Duty Neutral Floor Cleaner concentrate according to instructions on the label or use the "TruFill" Dispensing System.

BE SURE YOU KNOW THE CAPACITY OF THE TANK FOR PROPER DILUTION.



Step 2:

 Install the EZ Care Heavy Duty Scrub Pad (or other cleaning pad), Gray side down on the auto scrubber and clean the area.

Step 3:



 For best results when auto scrubbing, trail mop using a clean mop and diluted heavy-duty neutral floor cleaner solution to clean corners, edges, and hard to reach areas.

Step 4:

 Finish by thoroughly rinsing out the head and bucket.

Step 5:



Empty the dirty water from the autoscrubber recovery tank, remove and wipe down the squeegee and thoroughly rinse and hang the pads to dry.

Step 6:

After the floor is completely dry, remove the blockades and return the area to service.

BURNISHING PROCEDURES

DO NOT use any type of spray buff or restorative product.

Step 1:

 Install approved burnishing pad on the burnisher and begin burnishing the floor.

Step 2:

- Change your pad as often as needed; burnishing with a clean pad is essential to floor polishing success.
- Inspect the pad often to assure there hasn't been any debris picked up and held in the pad.



Step 3:

Dust mop entire area with a clean dust mop after burnishing.
