# **RESTROOM CARE & CLEANING PROCEDURES**







#### STEP 1 **GET STARTED**

Put on all personal protective equipment according to the label or SDS. Have all of the necessary cleaning products, protective equipment, signs, cleaning cloths and tools prepared.

- Knock on door
- Announce yourself
- Close restroom with proper signage



### STEP 2 III

#### PICK UP DEBRIS, REMOVE THE TRASH AND REPLACE LINERS

Wipe down trash receptacles. For optimal cleaning effectiveness, use TruShot 2.0° disinfectant cleaner. To finish stainless steel, use TruShot 2.0° Glass & Multi-Surface Cleaner.



#### STEP 3

DUST HORIZONTAL SURFACES AND SWEEP (OR DUSTMOP) FLOORS TO REMOVE ANY LOOSE SOIL.



## STEP 4 III


#### **APPLY TOILET BOWL CLEANER & RESTROOM CLEANER**

Apply SC Johnson Professional® acid or non-acid bowl cleaner to toilets and urinals. Spray the surrounding floor with disinfectant. Let cleaner dwell for contact time indicated on label.

Apply TruShot 2.0® Restroom Cleaner or TruShot 2.0° disinfectant cleaner on virtually any hard, non-porous surfaces except mirrors. Pay special attention to disinfect the following touch

- Door HandlesPush Plates
- Faucets
- Counters
- Flush Handles

Keep disinfected surfaces and touch points wet & allow cleaner to dwell for contact time indicated on product label.



## STEP 5 000

CHECK & REPLACE SC JOHNSON PROFESSIONAL® HAND SOAP AND SANITIZER, PAPER TOWEL AND TOILET PAPER. REPLENISH IF NECESSARY.

Clean and wipe dispensers with TruShot 2.0® disinfectant cleaner. If the dispensers\* are stainless steel you may want to use TruShot 2.0\* Glass & Multi-Surface Cleaner to ensure a smooth, reflective finish after disinfecting.

Use a designated cleaning cloth for disinfectants according to your microfiber program in place.



## TARGETED HYGIENE

Frequent, targeted cleaning & disinfection of commonly touched surfaces is essential to effectively remove soils, dirt, germs and other contaminants. This reduces the risk of cross contamination through surface contact.

# STEP 6 III

# CLEAN TOILETS AND URINALS.

Brush interior surfaces (including under the rim) of bowls and urinals with a toilet brush or "Johnny mop" and product applied earlier.

Clean the dividers and adjacent walls with a damp cloth or sponge to remove soil with product applied earlier.

Wipe down outside of the toilets and urinals. Flush toilet to complete procedure

Never use the same cleaning cloths or towels to clean bowls, urinals and other surfaces.



#### STEP 7 III

## **CLEAN ALL SURFACES**

Use TruShot 2.0® Glass & Multi-Surface Cleaner to clean mirrors, stainless surfaces and light fixtures. Wipe immediately with cloth.

Use microfiber cloth to remove soil. Wipe down sinks, faucets and all surrounding areas sprayed earlier.

If there is graffiti or other difficult soil, it may be necessary to use TruShot 2.0° Power Cleaner & Degreaser or Crème Cleanser to effectively clean.



#### STEP 8

#### **CLEAN THE FLOORS**

For best results, use a clean string mop or other specialized equipment & the SC Johnson Professional® Heavy Duty Neutral Floor Cleaner solution - diluted per label instructions.

- Daily Cleaning: 1 oz. / 4 gallons of waterHeavy Soils: 1 oz. / 2 gallons of water
- Apply cleaner to floor with back & forth motion.



In some settings, the SC Johnson Professional® Quaternary Disinfectant Cleaner is preferred for disinfecting the floors.

If the floor is a Grouted tile - use an appropriate brush to scrub when needed.



# **RETURN RESTROOM TO SERVICE**

Inspect using your cleaning checklist and return the restroom to service.

Make sure all your tools and equipment are ready to move onto the next job or into storage. If the floors are dry, pick up signs and prepare for your next assignment.
