## DISINFECTANT CLEANING PROCEDURES



PAY **SPECIAL ATTENTION** TO HIGH-RISK TOUCH POINTS WHEN CLEANING IN RESTROOMS OR GENERAL AREAS.











#### STEP 1 **GET STARTED**

Put on all personal protective equipment according to the label or SDS. Have all of the necessary cleaning products, protective equipment, signs, cleaning cloths and tools prepared.



### m STEP 2

#### MAKE NOTE OF ALL HIGH TOUCH POINT AREAS IN THE FACILITY

These are the areas frequently touched by occupants in the facility and can cause the spread of germs if not properly cleaned on a regular basis.



#### STEP 3

### APPLY DISINFECTANT ACCORDING TO LABEL **DIRECTIONS**

- Doorknobs

Never use the same cleaning cloths or towels to clean bowls, urinals and other surfaces.

## **CLEAN GARBAGE PAILS**

Dispose of waste. Wipe down and disinfect the outside of the garbage pails.
